IMAP advises Drokasa on the sale of its agrochemical division to Duwest

IMAP Peru (SUMMA) advised Drokasa's shareholders on the sale of its agrochemical business to Duwest, a leading agrochemical company in Central America with former ties to DuPont. Terms of the transaction were not disclosed.

Drokasa's agrochemical business and food industry supplies unit represent 62% of the company's revenues. This includes the production and distribution facility for several unique brands within a portfolio of products including fertilizers, herbicides and insecticides.

As part of the strategy, IMAP Peru executed the sale of Drokasa's personal care business unit and the spinoff of its cleaning products division.

The transaction marks Duwest's entry into the Peruvian market and a step towards expansion in the Latin America region.

IMAP Peru acted as Sole Financial Advisor to Drokasa on the transaction.
